We have been lucky enough to own this fabulous pub for the past eight years – though we have lived in the village for longer than that.

There has been a pub on this site since the mid-1700's, and we think (the records are a bit sketchy) we are the 18th landlords of the Bridge. Our aim is to look after the place during our time as custodians, and when we do eventually leave it to the 19th landlords, we will hopefully have left it just a little bit better than we found it.

Our vision at the Bridge Inn is hopefully a simple one - to match the world class location which nature has given us with an Inn that prides itself on friendly, professional service and great produce. And if that produce comes from the many local farms which surround us, or the waters around Scotland, or even from our own walled garden (visible from the canal) then even better. In our time here we have enlarged the downstairs bar, created a brand-new canal-side restaurant, and added four lovely bedrooms. (We have also added lots of other stuff behind the scenes, but that is usually of less interest to our customers). And we are continually trying to evolve the terrace and beer garden to make best use of this wonderful spot.

In the summer it's about outside drinks, barbecues and watching the canal traffic during the day, and lovely dinners of fabulous fresh seafood, meat, veggies and fruit by night. In the winter it's about keeping warm by the fires and maybe tapping your feet to some local live music.

And whatever the season, and whatever your age, you'll probably do it with a glass in your hand. In the summer it's rosé wine, Pimm's and crisp ales. In the winter it's luscious red wines, fabulous malt whiskies and warming local beers. Or whatever else takes your fancy. And there are always plenty of non-alcoholic options – or even our own fabulous teas. Hopefully this drinks list gives you a few ideas.

Malt Whisky

Highland

Glenmorangie Quinta Ruban 43.0% £4.75
Quinta Ruban is *Glenmorangie's* port finish. To craft this single malt they specially selected Port pipes from the Douro valley in Portugal.

Glenmorangie 46.0% £4.75
This whisky fuses a honeyed sweetness with notes of citrus, vanilla and almonds, to create a delicate, but satisfying flavour.

Glengoyne 12 40.0% £3.40
Glengoyne is one of the only Scottish whiskies to be distilled from completely unpeated malt - the malt is allowed to dry naturally before fermentation and distillation begin, resulting in an elegant, medium-bodied style.

Glengoyne 18 43.0% £6.75
A replacement for Glengoyne' 17yo that appeared in their revamped range in late 2012. A mix of refill sherry casks and a generous slug of first-fill sherry-matured whisky

Dalmore 12 43.0% £5.60
Dalmore 12 is aged for the first nine years in American white oak ex-bourbon casks, before half is transferred to ex-oloroso sherry casks for the final three years.

Dalwhinnie 15 40.0% £4.60
Elegant, smooth and medium-bodied, with a light, fruity palate and a whiff of heather on the finish

Old Pulteney 12 40.0% £3.60
Produced in the most northern distillery in Scotland, this whisky combines a flavour of sherry with sweet citrus notes and even a slight hint of brine.

Speyside

Aberlour 10 43.0% £4.60
Matured in hand-selected sherry oak casks, this whisky balances the fresh, fruity aromas of early autumn apples and pears with tastes of spicy-sweet nutmeg, vanilla and honey.

Benromach 10 40.0% £3.30
Grain by grain, drop by drop, this handcraft gorgeous Speyside single malt is crafted to taste the way whisky should. With rich sherry, fruit & nut chocolate, delicate spice, green apples, malty biscuit and a touch of light peat smoke.

Macallan Gold 43.0% £3.40
Lemon & orange peel with notes of vanilla & chocolate. Floral with light oak notes. boiled sweets on the palate.

Balvenie 12 Double Wood 43.0% £3.90
Aged in refill American oak casks before being finished in first fill European oak Sherry casks.

Glenfarclas 10 40.0% £3.40
Glenfarclas 10 is a straw-gold, delicately light, sweet and malty dram leaving a long slightly spicy finish. Always impeccably well-made, this is a whisky that always delivers in quality.



Island

Highland Park 12 40.0% £3.40

With a delicious sweetness (heather-honey is their preferred description) and a warming, silky.

Talisker 10 40.0% £3.80

A classic Island dram from the Isle of Skye. Always highly rated, lots of spice and fresh, tangy peat.

Jura 10 40.0% £3.40

Isle of Jura 10yo is an accessible, easy-drinking malt. Medium-bodied with a delicate sweet palate, with a hint of brine developing on the finish. A great introductory malt.

Jura Superstition 45.8% £4.00

A union of two Jura malt whisky styles: one bold, strong and peated, the other warm and delicate.

Islay

Bowmore 12 40.0% £3.80

Lemon and honey bouquet with the distinctive Bowmore smokiness. Warm and delicious on the palate with subtle dark chocolate flavours.

Laphroaig 10 40.0% £3.60

Full-bodied, smoky gem, with a residual sweetness and a hint of salt amid the seaweed, peaty characters before a long warming finish. A classic dram.

Ardbeg 10 40.0% £4.30

A burst of intense smoky fruit escapes into the atmosphere-peat infused with zesty lemon and lime, wrapped in waxy dark chocolate.

Lagavulin 16 40.0% £4.90

Massive peat-smoke that's typical of southern Islay - but also offering richness and a dryness that turns it into a truly interesting dram.

Glenkinchie 12 43.0% £3.50

'The Edinburgh Malt' Just twenty miles from the hustle and bustle of the capital.

Glenkinchie Distillers Edition 43.0% £5.25

Sweet, soft start that becomes flowery. It then turns crisp mid-palate, with a herbal and dry finish.

Auchentoshan Three Wood 43.0% £5.25

Matured initially in bourbon casks before being finished in Oloroso then Pedro Ximénez casks for an extra layer of rich, sweet fruitiness.
